Our Readings give us a stark contrast. In the First, we are explicitly told that God listens to the poor and marginalised rather than the wealthy. How often do we hear of the wealthy paying massive sums to attend dinners with political leaders being specifically promised access depending on what they pay? Can we think of any other profession which provides close access for cash?

With our Gospel, something I cannot repeat enough, Jesus is condemning a mindset, not the Pharisees, not any supposed aspect of Judaism, but the mindset which asserts one's own superiority in morality against another's and even preens about it

The Pharisee is just about telling God how lucky God is to have the Pharisee as a follower! He even lists all the sins of others – which apparently he is immune to! Have we met anyone like this? Or have we ever been so tempted? Or even fallen?

His apparent attitude of self-satisfaction appears to be that he has 'earned' his way to God, without needing any help. This is called 'Pelagianism'.

The contrast with the second person is telling. He acknowledges his fault, and asks for help. What is his fault.? We do not know. It might be personal. It might be his role as a tax collector. Is he doing this out of choice — or is he trapped in a system where he needs to support his family?

We are not told and do not need to be. If we place ourselves in this parable, which of the pair are we?


